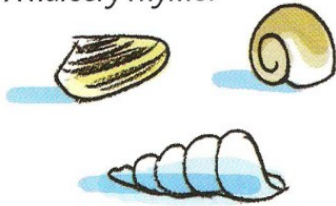

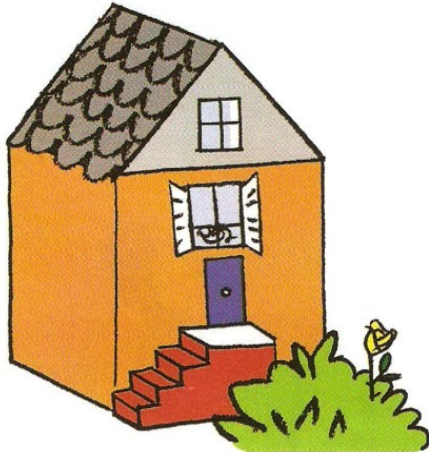
Mary Mary

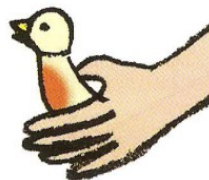
